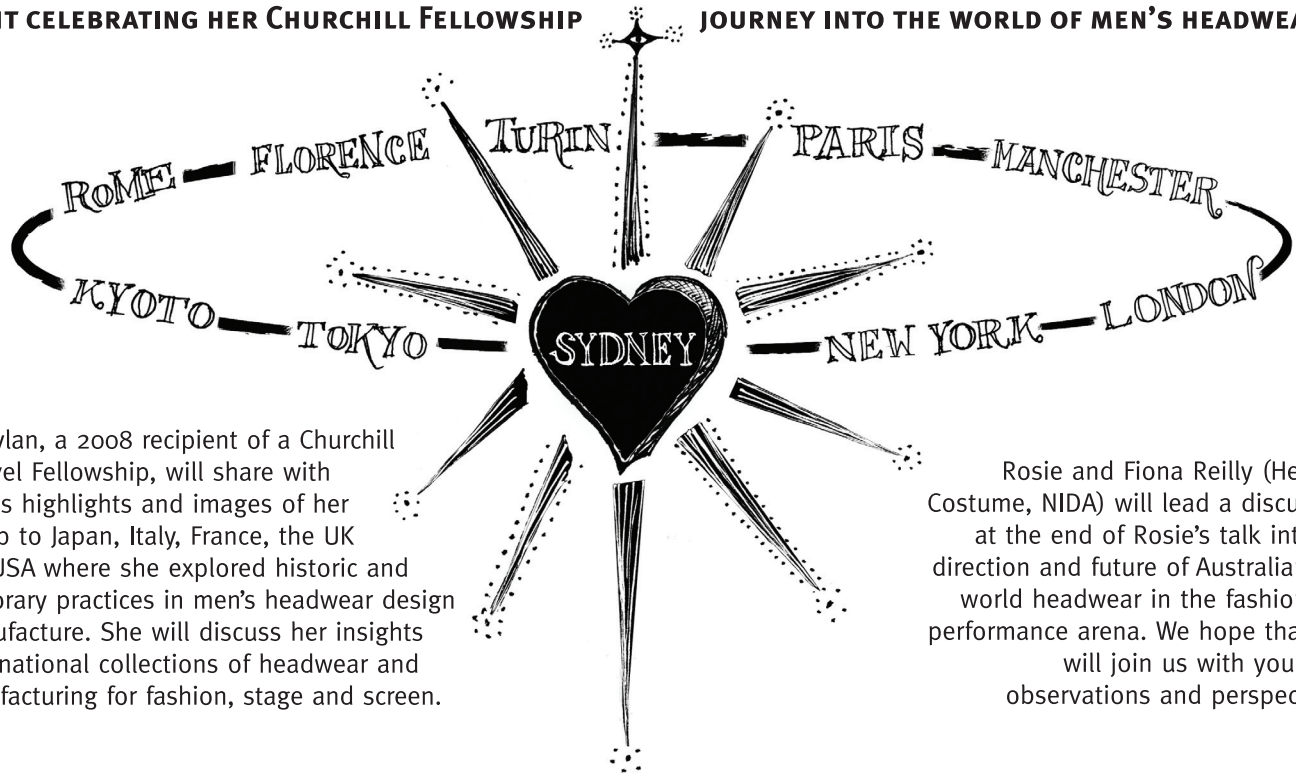


THE FELLOWSHIP OF THE HAT
